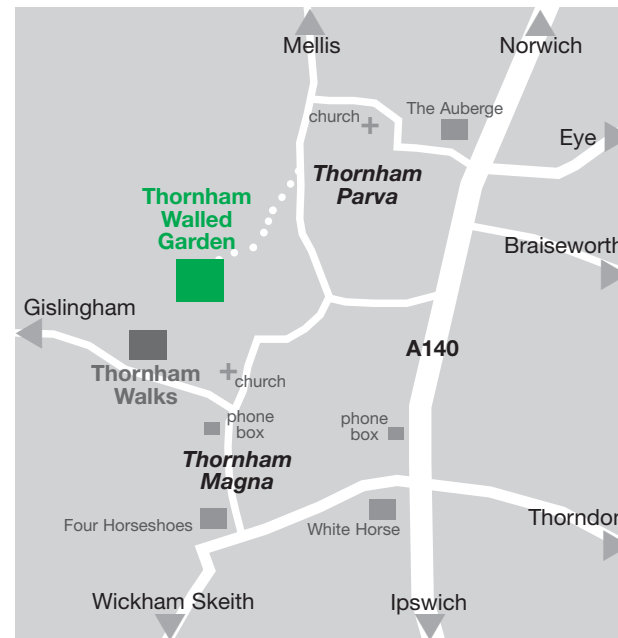

# What is Beyond the Wall?

Beyond the Wall is an educational project that works with disadvantaged young people aged 16 to 25 but does not preclude adults who continue to experience obstacles to learning and living in the community. Beyond the Wall strives to diminish those obstacles, focusing and expanding on what one can do rather than what one cannot. Emphasis is on the obtainable, learning and maintaining skills, building confidence and unlocking opportunities for the future in mainstream education, sheltered volunteering or employment.

Beyond the Wall staff work with a variety of organisations as a provider, offering activities in Horticulture, Conservation, Personal and Social Skills with potential throughout the week to access Photography, Floristry and ICT workshops.



# What do we do?

We provide a safe place with a work environment with work style rules and expectations where the referred young people can have freedom to learn at their own level and pace with as much or as little support as needed.

We are open daily during term time and Monday, Tuesday and Friday out of term 48 weeks a year.

Our main individual and group objectives are:

- To extend concentration spans
- To develop tolerance of others, and respect for the needs of others
- To promote small group or team working
- To use established skills in ways relevant to the activities on offer and develop them further
- To learn to complete a set of tasks before moving on to activities of choice or habit
- To work towards, where appropriate, City & Guilds accredited qualifications in Horticultural Skills Level 1 and Land Based qualifications and Entry Level Skills for Working Life.
